Biological Oceanography: Plankton Ecology Research at the Bedford Institute of Oceanography 1962-2012

Ecological research on plankton has been conducted at Bedford Institute of Oceanography for more than 50 years. From 1962-2012, the overarching goals remained as originally envisioned by the founders: "to describe pathways and to measure amounts and rates of energy transfer in marine biological communities; and to study the structure and degree of organization of biological systems in the sea". Here, a narrative is presented that links the initial exploration of various new oceanographic vistas, the subsequent building of conceptual and methodological foundations, the consequent reductionistic examination of processes and mechanisms, the emergent synthesis of system description, and the challenge towards ecological futures.
