Reparations as an economic and social development strategy to overcome the legacy of enslavement, colonization and cultural genocide

In this lecture, Delvina Bernard will explain what reparations entail and what is currently being done in Nova Scotia and around the world to make amends for the harm done to people of African descent.



DELVINA BERNARD

is an African Nova Scotian and an educator, human rights activist, singer/songwriter and institutional change strategist. Ms. Bernard is a founding member of numerous organizations and initiatives in the education, performing arts, community economic development and gender justice sectors. She has held senior positions with the federal government, not for profit and private sectors including being executive director of the Council on African Canadian Education and policy lead to the Nova Scotia Department of Education on redressing historical inequities for Black Learners. Currently, Ms. Bernard is the Equity, Diversity, Inclusion and Accessibility Advisor to Mount Saint Vincent University. Ms. Bernard is also a PhD Candidate at Saint Mary's University.
