Intergenerational fisheries access and the future of fish as food

In Canada, access to marine resources and ocean spaces is a significant issue for many coastal and Indigenous communities due to intensifying activity and competition in the marine environment. The general trend of loss of access has implications for these communities, and for Canadian society.



MEGAN BAILEY is a Canada Research Chair in Integrated Ocean and Coastal Governance at Dalhousie's Marine Affairs Program. Her work recognizes the need for collaboration among multiple groups including governments, NGO's and industry in the sustainable management of the global seafood supply chain. She most recently helped establish an interdisciplinary program to create a sustainable transboundary tuna fishery in the Western and Central Pacific. She also works in the area of food security and fisheries and market-based conservation.

Megan has authored numerous articles and book chapters and this year published her first edited book "Food Secure Futures: Multidisciplinary Solutions". She currently serves on the Scientific and Technical Advisory Committee for the International Pole and Line Foundation, on the Board of Directors for the Ecology Action Centre, and on the Communications Committee for the Fishermen and Scientists Research Society.
